### **READINGS 4 June – Trinity Sunday**

### Isaiah 40. 12-17, 27-end

- Who has measured the waters in the hollow of his hand and marked off the heavens with a span, enclosed the dust of the earth in a measure, and weighed the mountains in scales and the hills in a balance?
- <sup>13</sup> Who has directed the spirit of the LORD, or as his counsellor has instructed him?
- <sup>14</sup> Whom did he consult for his enlightenment, and who taught him the path of justice?

Who taught him knowledge,

and showed him the way of understanding?

- <sup>15</sup> Even the nations are like a drop from a bucket, and are accounted as dust on the scales; see, he takes up the isles like fine dust.
- <sup>16</sup> Lebanon would not provide fuel enough, nor are its animals enough for a burnt-offering.
- <sup>17</sup> All the nations are as nothing before him; they are accounted by him as less than nothing and emptiness.
- <sup>27</sup> Why do you say, O Jacob, and speak, O Israel,
- 'My way is hidden from the LORD, and my right is disregarded by my God'?
- <sup>28</sup> Have you not known? Have you not heard?

The LORD is the everlasting God,

the Creator of the ends of the earth.

He does not faint or grow weary;

his understanding is unsearchable.

- <sup>29</sup> He gives power to the faint, and strengthens the powerless.
- <sup>30</sup> Even youths will faint and be weary, and the young will fall exhausted;
- <sup>31</sup> but those who wait for the LORD shall renew their strength, they shall mount up with wings like eagles,
- they shall run and not be weary, they shall walk and not faint.

### 2 Corinthians 13, 11-end


<sup>11</sup> Finally, brothers and sisters, farewell. Put things in order, listen to my appeal, agree with one another, live in peace; and the God of love and peace will be with you. <sup>12</sup> Greet one another with a holy kiss. All the saints greet you.

<sup>13</sup> The grace of the Lord Jesus Christ, the love of God, and the communion of the Holy Spirit be with all of you.

<sup>16</sup> Now the eleven disciples went to Galilee, to the mountain to which Jesus had directed them. <sup>17</sup> When they saw him, they worshipped him; but some doubted. <sup>18</sup> And Jesus came and said to them, 'All authority in heaven and on earth has been given to me. <sup>19</sup> Go therefore and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, <sup>20</sup> and teaching them to obey everything that I have commanded you. And remember, I am with you always, to the end of the age.'
