PROPOSAL: EIA Scoping Request for the Extraction and Processing of Sand and Gravel, Recycling of Inert Materials, and Associated Infrastructure.

Notice is hereby given that the County Council as Highway Authority make the following comments:

A planning application for the above proposal should include a Transport Statement (or equivalent document) detailing the following:

- Quantity, vehicle type and duration of vehicle trips associated with the proposal and any committed developments in the area;
 - As there is an increase in trips and traffic from this proposal, this could present a detrimental impact to the road network, so it is important that transport is assessed appropriately.
- Vehicle routes associated with the proposal and details of how these will be enforced;
- Assessment of the new access arrangements;
- Assessment of any recorded injury accidents close to the proposal site;
- Details of any changes to the highway impact of the proposal when compared to the existing arrangement;
- Parking, manoeuvring and any other on-site highway related matters including any measures to improve the sustainability of the proposal.
